The Adopt-A-Family guidelines have changed this year due to Covid-19. Gift cards are requested so that clients will be able to buy the gifts and food for their families.

Suggested gift cards could be Walmart, Canadian Tire, Tim Horton's etc. Gift certificates for the Town Center Mall would also be welcomed as the client could choose the store to visit (except LCBO and the Dollar Store).

Cards for groceries are also needed for a total of \$100 (4 at \$25.00)

- 2. Place the envelope with the gift card on the offering plate or in the mail slot at the church.
- 3. All cards must be into the church by Monday, November 30.
